## **MISTLETOE - THE REAL STORY**


Mistletoe is a parasite. It steals water and nutrients from trees. Technically, it is a "hemiparasite" which means it can produce some of its own resources through photosynthesis. It just needs an energetic kick from the sun to fuel the biological siege and subsequent invasion of a tree. The Mistletoe needs to break through a tree's defenses to grow and complete its life cycle. Once inside the tree most of the mistletoe's energy requirements are met by re-

sources stolen from the host tree.

Unlike Spanish moss, Mistletoe is a parasite. Most of its

seeds are spread by birds. If the defecated seeds land on a branch it attaches itself to the new host tree. The parasite releases a compound called viscin which dries to form a stiff biological cement. Most of the Mistletoe's seeds will wait until the following spring before they germinate. Viscin ensures that the seed is in for the long haul.

Most plants grow towards the light, sun, and use gravity to form their growth patterns. Mistletoe does its own thing and grows away from the light and towards the tree. It also ignores gravity so that it can infect the tree in any direction.



Once the parasite is inside the tree, it manipulates the

host and steals all the resources that are needed to grow, flower, and produce seeds.

Few parasites enjoy the seasonal celebration that we see and hear while standing under the mistletoe during the holiday season.

Beware of claims about Mistletoe's value as an alternative medicine. Don't eat the berries! While they are enjoyed by critters, they're poisonous to us.

Mistletoe does contain compounds called lectins which are being looked at as a potential cancer treatment." Dr. Johnathan J. Dalzell.

Again, do not eat the berries. They are toxic and may cause vomiting, blurred vision, and seizures. Mistletoe plants have learned how to work together to get

Mistletoe plants have learned how to work together to get the most out of a host tree like squeezing the last bit of toothpaste out of the tube.

In a co-infection, more than one Mistletoe plant infects the tree. Each plant will increase its own levels of photosynthesis taking a little out of the tree. They work together to keep the tree alive longer. When there is significant mistletoe on a branch, pruning that limb may be your only solution. There are chemicals to kill the mistletoe unfortunately it will also kill the tree.

Mistletoe is not a Florida parasite but much of it is in our homes during the holiday season. It's been around for a long time and has been mentioned in Greek and Roman myth. Over time these plants have developed unique and hardy systems to survive.

Enjoy the holiday season.

The Mistletoe tradition comes from Norse mythology. In the Norse culture, the Mistletoe plant was a sign of love and peace. The story goes that the goddess Figg lost her son (the god Baldur) to an arrow made of Mistletoe. After his death she vowed that Mistletoe would kiss anyone who passed beneath it so long as it was never again used as a weapon.

The kissing tradition as we know it appears to have started in 18th century England where it first became widely used as a Christmas decoration. The tradition spread quickly throughout the world. Beginning as a custom among the lower classes, it made its way to all classes, becoming a universal holiday ritual.






