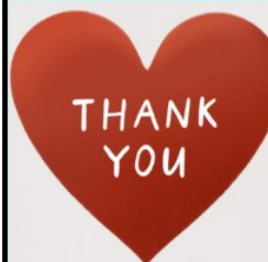

The time of year is fast approaching once again when the grandkids and great-grandkids and their folks will be visiting on their way to one or more of the awesome attractions we have here in the Sunshine State. For their safety and the safety of everyone around them here in Southport Springs it is important that they understand

a few especially important safety rules.

First, do not let them "sweet talk" you into letting them drive your golf cart. Each year there are more than 6,000 serious golf cart accidents involving young people under the age of 16. Some result in permanent life changing injuries. You do not want, and we do not want your grandchild or great-grandchild to be one of those statistics. So please do not let them drive your gulf cart.

Second, if you see a young person driving a golf cart, please report it immediately to the community office.

A second reminder to those visiting is that for the safety of everyone concerned, jumping into the pool or running around near the pool is absolutely prohibited. Here again, the last thing we need is to see is the local Rescue Squad taking someone to the hospital with a serious life threatening injury. Rules are not meant to punish. They are meant to keep everyone safe.

Memorial Wall Restoration Fund

As of November 14th, the Memorial Wall Restoration Fund has received in donations:

\$5,265.00

These funds allow for the restoration of the Memorial Wall dedicated June 2014. The following actions are currenting underway to that end:

- Apply concrete sealant to all existing cracks across the memorial wall.
- Remove black patina stains from all existing bricks.
- Add missing concrete blocks to the rear of the wall to provide complete support to the missing areas of the wall.
- Pressure wash complete wall after filling existing voids throughout the wall.
- Apply missing concrete to the foundation of the wall.
- Repair/Replace lighting.
- Apply missing black paint to over 500 bricks missing paint.

This is a 200+ year old Christmas drink.

Batter ingredients:

- 3 large eggs separated
- 1/4 lb butter at room temperature
- 1/8 tsp salt
- 1/2 lb powdered sugar
- 1/2 oz dark or amber Rum

- 1/8 tsp allspice
- 1/4 tsp nutmeg
- 1/4 tsp cloves
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon
- 1Tbsp Vanilla extract

This can be doubled, tripled or more easily depending on needs



Tom and Jerry cocktail (per drink)

- 1 oz Rum (amber or dark)
- 1 oz Cognac
- 4 tbsp Tom and Jerry Batter
- 6-8 oz warm whole milk (best) or water
- Freshly grated nutmeg for garnish

Instructions:

Batter:

Beat egg yolks until pale. In a separate bowl beat egg whites and salt until stiff peaks form. In a third bowl beat butter and powdered sugar until light and fluffy; beat in egg yolks and vanilla. Stir in spices and Rum until well blended. Gently fold egg whites into egg yolk mixture trying not to knock the air out of the egg whites. The batter should be thick and foamy when all incorporated.

Make the drink:

Pour boiling water into mugs to warm them and let them set for a minute or two, then dump out the water.

Add 2-4 Tbsp of the batter to the warm mug and then add 1 oz of Rum and 1 oz of Cognac. Slowly pour the warm milk (or water) into the mug slowly stirring constantly (very important). Garnish with nutmeg. Enjoy!

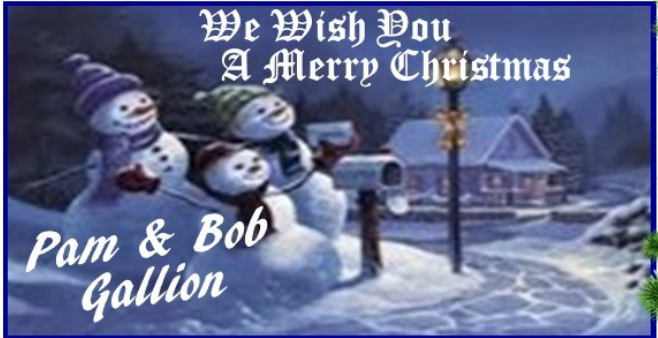

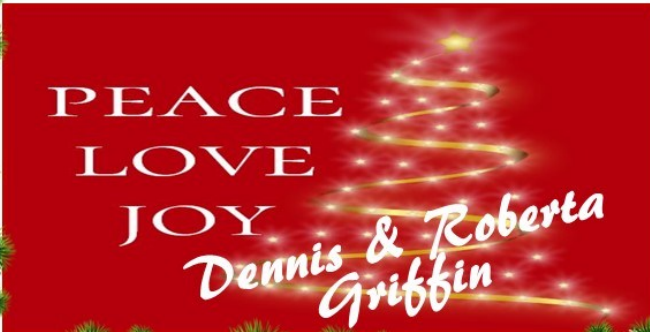
