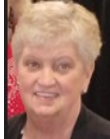

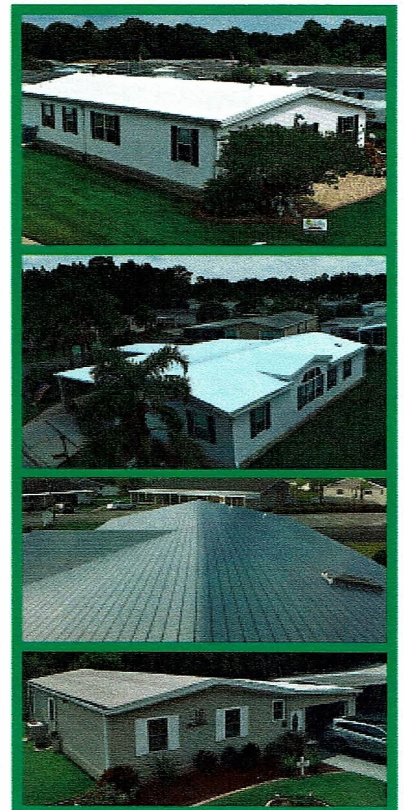

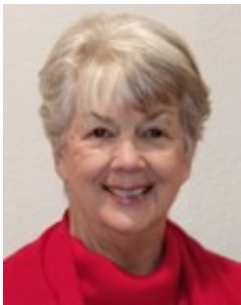
## The Women's Club

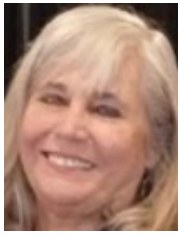

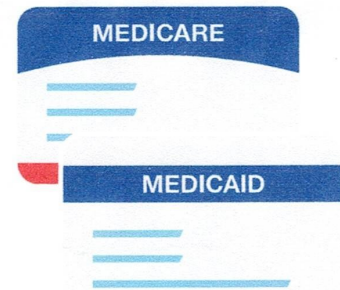

## Most Common Mulching Mistakes



When it comes to maintaining healthy plants and weed free flower beds, mulch is the answer. However, it must be done correctly.

For starters, mulch helps to regulate soil temperatures and keeps roots from getting too warm or cold. It also helps retain moisture around the roots of plants, keeping them properly hydrated even through very hot days.

Let's face it, the number one reason to put down mulch is to stop weeds.

For many who go through the expense and effort of mulching flower beds each year in hopes of putting an end to their weeding chores, be aware, done poorly the process may make it worse.

Mulching only helps control the weeds if done correctly. Using improper mulch can destroy the soils strength and vitality.

This article will look at the most common mistakes we see.

The mulch you use does make a big difference in how well you manage to keep the weeds out.

When mulching annuals, perennials, bushes, shrubs, and trees it is best to avoid stone of any type, synthetic rubber, or any other type of non-nutrient filled mulch as they add nothing to soil strength or vitality.

Stone heats up fast. As it does it also heats up the soil, drying it out and possibly damaging the root system of more tender annuals and perennials. Additionally, the stone does not break down nor contribute to the soil's nutrient value. The same problems exist for synthetic mulches such as rubber. While rubber is easier to walk on, it's hotter on the surface than stone increasing your risk of sun stroke or other heat related conditions in the summer if you are working in that area. Rubber as it compacts can block water getting to the roots.

To eliminate weeds, mulch must form a barrier between the environment and soil. When it does it keeps weed seeds from ending up on the ground where they need to be to germinate. When working on small beds laying several layers of newspaper over the area and under the mulch helps as it makes it more difficult for seeds to end up on the soil.

So, what is the best mulch to use?

Shredded hardwood or hardwood bulk. Do not get triple shredded wood or hardwood dust. Cypress is not as good as it tends to get tangled. Blocking the flow of water to the soil. In our community red/brown shredded mulch is required. Any other mulch type must be approved by the community manager.

Before beginning the mulching process, first remove existing weeds by digging them up or spray applied weed killer. You may need several treatments to kill the weed before throwing mulch. If there is any green showing the weed will continue to grow. Simply cutting the existing weeds to ground level is not adequate. They will grow back. To be effective a 3-to-4-inch treatment may be required. Less than 3 inches of mulch really has little chance of working.

### Bad Omens Many People Take for Granted

We have always been fascinated by what the future may hold. Our curiosity pushes us to glance at what lies beyond the horizon, creating a list of very strange ideas. Let's look at some of these myths that are still common today. In many cultures a black cat crossing your path is seen as a bad omen. It likely stems from the association of black cats to witch craft during the Middle Ages when they were often believed to be

witches.

However, in some instances, black cats are symbols of good luck. Sailors were known for favoring black cats as company on board ships.

Today many people keep them as house pets and are no longer part of a very old superstition.

Breaking a mirror is said to bring 7 years of bad luck. It is a belief that began in ancient Rome where mirrors were seen as portals to the soul. The idea was, damaging one's reflection could harm your spirit or anger the Gods, who were believed to spy on mere mortals through mirrors.

To be fair antiquity mirrors were difficult to manufacture and considered to be prize possessions. So, it is plausible that taboos arose around breaking one. Why 7 years of bad luck? Romans believed the body renewed every 7 years, meaning technically no curse could last for more than that! Think about this as it is also the thought behind the seven-year itch.

Crows and Ravens have long been associated with various myths and legends. Ancient Romans also believed that a crow's call predicted pending doom.

Celtic traditions linked these birds to battles and death. The Norse Gods were often accompanied by a pair of them and considered to be passengers or spies of the gods.

For Native Americans ravens were seen as tricksters like coyotes playing tricks on mere mortals.

These superstitions deserve some credit as ravens and crows are known to be amongst the most intelligent animals we know with cognitive skills like the great apes!

Spilling salt has been seen as an ill omen for centuries, and even today some people flinch at the sight of spilled salt. In ancient times salt was so valuable that it was often used as payment. To counteract the bad luck associated with a spill, some believe tossing a pinch of the spilled salt over the left shoulder can ward off evil spirits.

For a millennia strange animal behavior has been seen as an omen of impending misfortune. Surprisingly this superstition may have roots in actual truth as the act of animals fleeing or acting restless before a natural disaster has been observed repeatedly. It was reported in 373BC that rats, dogs, snakes, etc. had vacated a city just days prior to a major earthquake.

Scientists even suggest that animals detect minute electromagnetic signals in the atmosphere, triggering a panic or awareness.

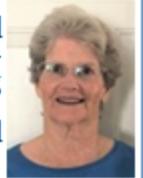

## THE MIAMI VICE

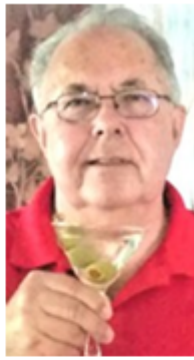
A great mix of two different drinks

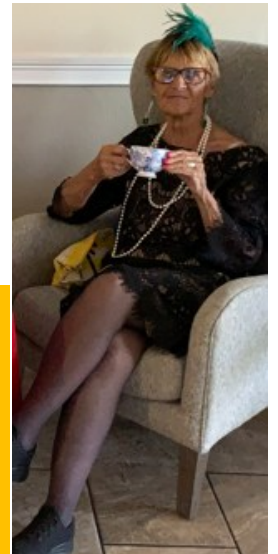
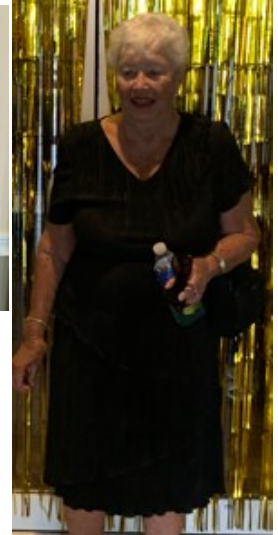
