July - Personal items and school supplies will be collected for Joshua House, located in Lutz, which cares for abused, abandoned and neglected children.

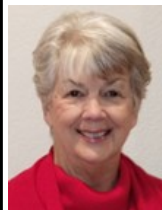
September/October - We will again participate in the Two Good Soles Event, where we will collect new socks and closed-toed shoes for Pasco County students.

Pasco is getting disaster relief

This is Susan Slater, your District President for District 11. I over see Pasco and Hernando, but have no idea which parks are in Hernando. Therefore, if your park is in Hernando, this email does not apply to you. It is ONLY for Pasco County Residents.

Pasco County applied for a grant for disaster relief and received \$585,000,000 to disburse to residents for certain things like infrastructure, housing and more. The link will bring you to those answers along with three meetings you can attend to have input on how the money will be spent.

I have been asked by the agency to contact people in mobile homes. I can only get to the FMO residents, therefore am using the mailing list to inform you of what is happening. How you find out after will be on your own. I did not sustain any damage so have no claims to bring you through the process. And this is not an FMO project. I just happen to find out about it at a Chamber of Commerce meeting and said I would at least spread the word about the meetings.

They are looking to get people informed in mobile homes because of all the damage from Helene and Milton and one before that (not Debbie). If you have any questions, refer to the link below to the website as this is all I know and will know.

June Bug Cocktail

A sweet and slightly tangy summer cocktail

Ingredients

1. Midori Melon Liqueur: 0.5 oz (15ml)
2. Banana Liqueur: 0.5 oz (15ml)
3. Coconut Rum: 0.5 oz (15ml)
4. Pineapple Juice: 2 oz (60ml)
5. Lemon or Lime Juice: 1 oz (30ml)
6. Ice
7. Garnish: Cherry and/or a slice of pineapple

Instructions

- Pour Midori Melon Liqueur, Banana Liqueur, and Coconut Rum into a shaker.
- Add Pineapple Juice and Lemon or Lime Juice to the shaker.
- Fill the shaker with ice and shake vigorously until well chilled.
- Strain the mixture into a tall glass filled with ice.
- Garnish with a cherry or a slice of pineapple.

Can You Reuse Potting Soil



Whether you are sprucing up your spring flower beds or planting this seasons harvest, potting soil is a necessity to guarantee your plants get the energy they need to thrive.

Made from in-ground soil, potting soil, is dirt like you find in your yard. It has mineral elements, including sand, clay, and loam. It is often fortified with organics to increase its nutritional value.

Packaged potting soil is good for 2 years. If it is older, you can still make use of it by adding new soil with it or spread it over your existing flower beds. It is best kept in the original bag, resealed and kept outside, versus inside your shed where it will dry out quickly.

When your plants are thriving, they are using up nutrients that exist in the soil which must be replenished before it can be reused. I recommend using an all-purpose, slow release, organic plant food that contains macro elements new plants will need to grow in the upcoming months. Make sure the soil's ph is between 6.5 and 7.5 Amended when needed.

If you're not sure that the old potting soil is free of disease or pests, just throw it away.

I encourage those who do lots of container planting to make their own compost or as a second choice, use Black Kow. This adds nutrients and microbes to the soil, 1 part compost and 3 parts potting soil.

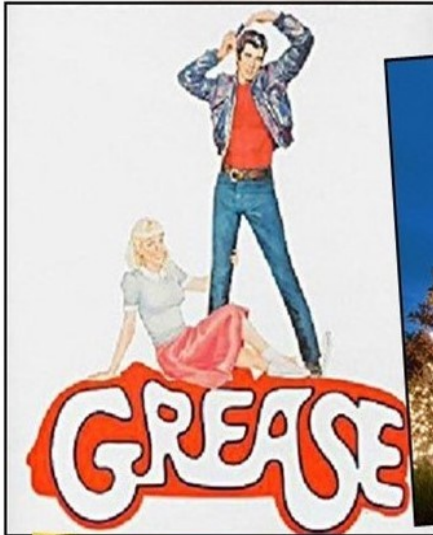

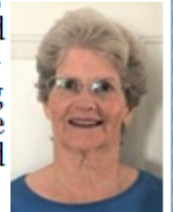
